Board News

I hope this message finds you well. I wanted to take this opportunity to provide you with an update on recent activities of the Board. Our bi-monthly meeting was held recently to discuss various matters concerning ANZSRS and to ensure the smooth functioning of our society. In addition, we are reviewing our bylaws and other corporate documentation.

We are excited to inform you that there are numerous ANZSRS opportunities currently available and on the horizon. Each Director is working diligently on expressions of interest, as well as updating and refining position descriptions to better support individuals who express their interest in these roles. We strongly encourage all current ANZSRS members to apply for any of these roles. As vacancies arise, we will notify all members via email, providing specific details.

Given the passage of several years without the ability to meet in person, and the recent influx of new members, I would like to briefly explain the Board structure and the operations within our society. ANZSRS is a not-for-profit organisation run entirely by volunteer position holders. The Board consists of six directors, each overseeing specific portfolios (see the structure here). Elected Directors serve a three-year term and have the option to re-nominate for up to three terms.

The Director portfolios are assigned among the Board members, and under each portfolio. there are various subcommittees, regional chairs position holders. The term for the subcommittee members and position holders will vary. The President and Vice President are elected by the Board, immediately following the Annual General Meeting and once elected, will serve a two year term. This person must already be on the Board of Directors to assume either of these roles.

Regional chairs play a crucial role in our society. They organise regular face-to-face meetings and events, act as a conduit for information between the Board and local members, and facilitate communication among members. They also provide support to their local community and foster relationships between new and existing members. Regional chairs serve a two-year term, which is due to end next month.
